Description of content: This Draft Uganda Standard specifies requirements, methods of sampling and test for in-shell raw cashew nut obtained from the cashew tree (<i>Anacardium occidentale</i> , Linnaeus) for further processing. This standard does not apply to raw cashew kernels. This Draft Uganda Standard was also notified to the SPS Committee.
