Description of content: This Resolution contains provisions on packaging and labeling requirements for the market authorization of a sanitizing product that is corrosive to the skin or that causes serious eye damage. This Resolution applies to national or imported sanitizing products that presents corrosive characteristics, in tests carried out following the Organization for Economic Co-operation and Development - OECD methodologies or their updates, or alternative methodologies, as long as they are recognized by the health authority.

Objective and rationale, including the nature of urgent problems where applicable: This Resolution has the objective of establishing packaging and labeling requirements for the market authorization of sanitizing products that are corrosive to the skin or that cause serious eye damage.; Protection of human health or safety
