5. Title, number of pages and language(s) of the notified document: Textiles – High Density Polyethylene (HDPE)/ Polypropylene (PP) Woven Sacks for Packaging Fertilizers (Quality Control) Order, 2023; (1 page(s), in English)
6. Description of content: The Order seeks to ensure conformity of the Textiles – High Density Polyethylene (HDPE)/ Polypropylene (PP) Woven Sacks for Packaging Fertilizers to the Indian Standard, as amended from time to time, as specified in the Table of the Order.

7.	<p>Objective and rationale, including the nature of urgent problems where applicable: This Indian standard is of HDPE/ PP woven sacks of 45 kg capacity for packaging of neem coated urea fertilizers and 50 kg capacity for packaging of other than neem coated urea fertilizers, either produced indigenously or imported in bulk and repacked in sacks.</p> <p>Based on packaging capacity, the HDPE/PP woven sacks shall be classified as under: a) Type I — Sacks having nominal capacity of 45 kg for packaging of neem coated urea fertilizers; and b) Type II — Sacks having nominal capacity of 50 kg for packaging of other than neem coated urea fertilizers.</p> <p>The Order seeks to ensure that the locally manufactured or imported goods shall conform to the Indian Standard IS 9755:2021 and shall bear the standard mark under license from the Bureau of Indian Standards (BIS) as per Scheme-I of Schedule-II of the Bureau of Indian Standards (Conformity Assessment) Regulations, 2018. The use of standard mark is governed by the provisions of Bureau of Indian Standards Act, 2016 and the Rules and Regulations made thereunder. Bureau of Indian Standards shall be the certifying and enforcing authority.</p>
